- (b) Define sex ratio. What is the sex ratio of Assam as per 2011 Census? Compare it with the sex ratio of India.
- (c) What is 'regional domestic product'? How does it differ from the 'national domestic product'?
- (d) What is 'shifting cultivation'?
- (e) What do you mean by 'cropping pattern' of a region?
- **2.** Answer any *four* of the following questions within 125 words each :  $5\times4=20$ 
  - (a) Write a note on the occupational distribution of the population of the North-Eastern States.
  - (b) Compare the status of the banking sector in Assam with the rest of India.
  - (c) Mention the changes in the composition of the State income of Assam over the planning era.
  - (d) State the basic features of the industrial policy of Assam.
  - (e) Write a note on the role and functions of any one of the following:
    - (i) NEDFI
    - (ii) DONER

- **3.** Answer any *four* of the following questions within 350 words each:  $15\times4=60$ 
  - (a) Discuss the demographic features of the North-Eastern States highlighting the changes observed in the 2011 Census.
  - (b) Highlight the advancements made in the transport and communication sector in the North-Eastern region in the post-liberalisation era.
  - (c) Discuss the nature and extent of the problems of poverty and unemployment in Assam.
  - (d) Identify the differences in the agricultural practices in the 'hills' and the 'plains' in Assam. Which of these practices are considered to be more productive and why?
  - (e) Critically discuss the factors responsible for slow rate of industrialisation of Assam.
  - (f) What are the special measures taken for the development of the North-Eastern region in the post-liberalisation era? Discuss their impact.
