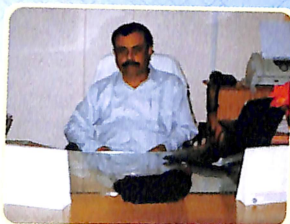

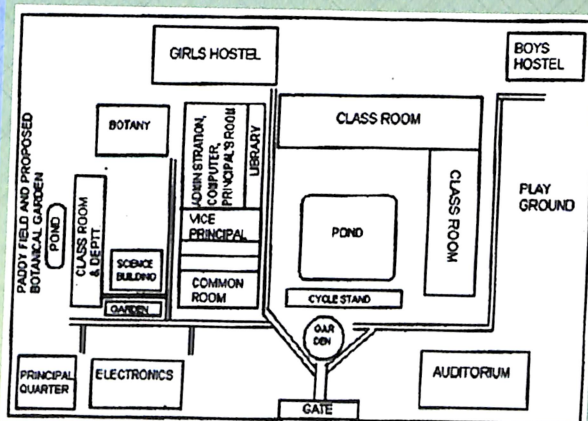

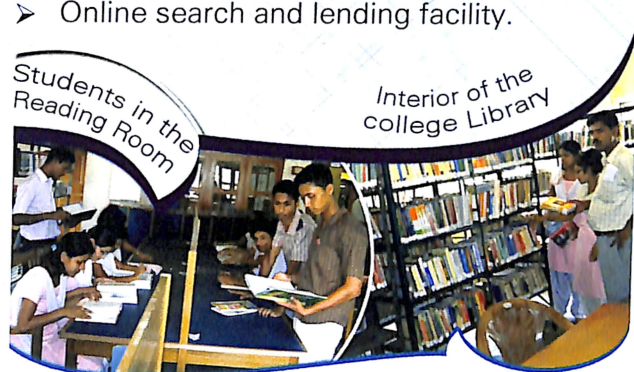
### HOSTEL FACILITIES :

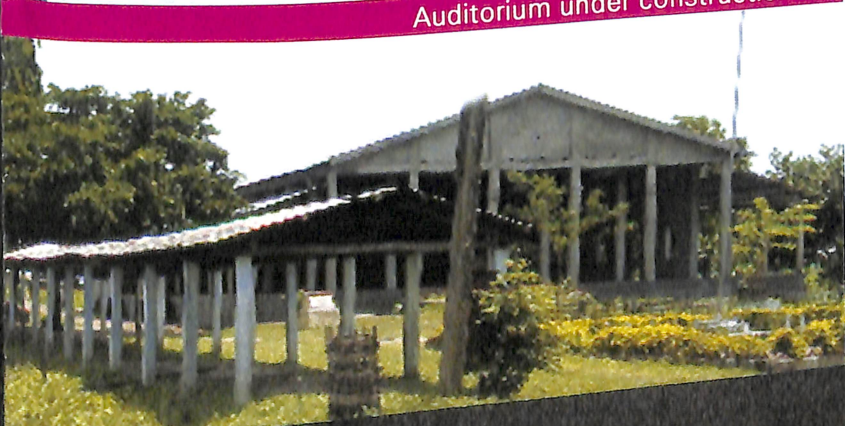


Lab cum class room under construction
